



## ED537 ENTREPRENEURIAL COMPETENCE DEVELOPMENT

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### ABSTRACT

The course "Entrepreneurial Competence Development" is aimed at forming and developing specific competencies related to entrepreneurship. Entrepreneurship is the ability to turn ideas into action. This includes: developing creativity, innovation, and risk-taking, as well as the ability to plan and manage projects to achieve goals. The European Union defines entrepreneurship and initiative as one of the eight key competences for lifelong learning, which every educational system in the member states must ensure that young people acquire in school and even in kindergarten.

The new Law on Public Education takes successful steps through entrepreneurship education to achieve the main goals of the education system in a market economy:

- Formation of a new way of thinking and attitude to the world,
- A position that combines the link between education and life as a whole
- Adaptability to the conjuncture of the educational and labor market.

The academic course examines problems related to the possibilities of integrated education and the implementation of interdisciplinary links between various cultural and educational fields and, at first glance, incompatible subjects: Home Economics and Technology, Fine Arts, Home Economics and Economics, Music, Technology, Man and Society, Mathematics, Information Technology, The World Around Us, Homeland, Geography and Economics, Man and Nature, etc. (in school) and in the same way the possibilities for integrating educational areas in kindergarten.

The multiple influences of the main factors: family, kindergarten and school, social environment in relation to the formation of entrepreneurial competencies are analyzed. New accents are placed on the organization of education aimed at forming an entrepreneurial culture and relationships, and modern variable technologies for education, teaching, and learning are offered.
